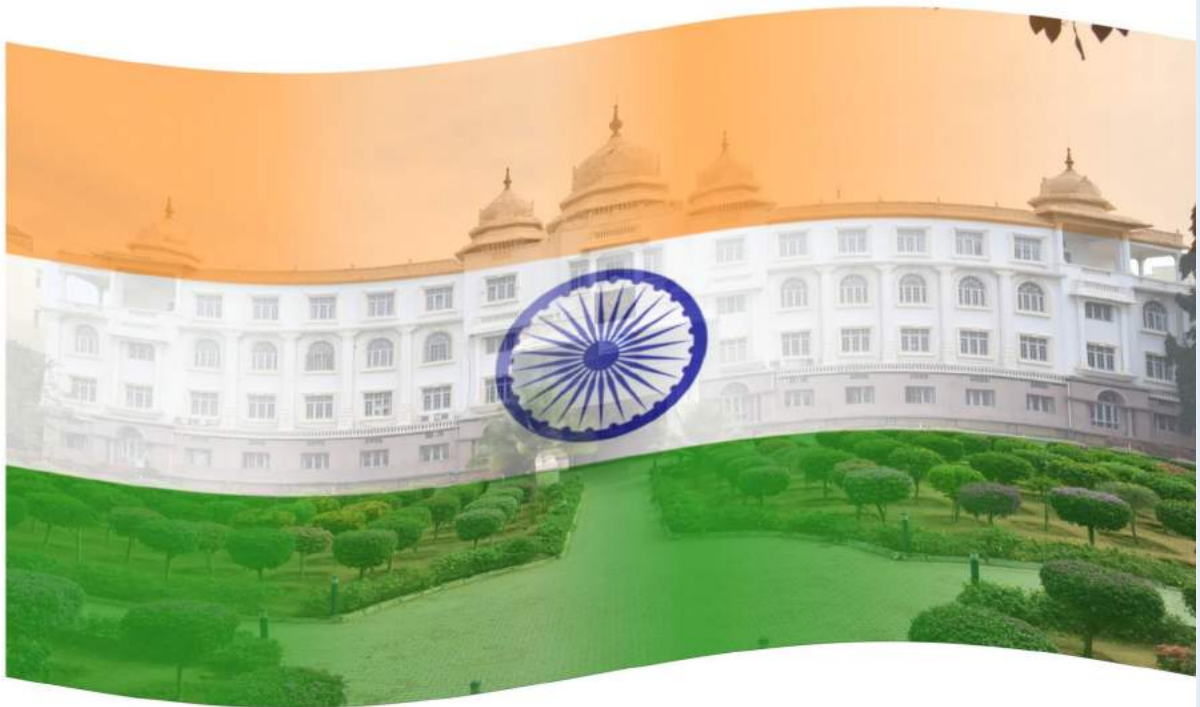

COLLEGE REPORT



Sri Devaraj Urs Medical College, a unit of Sri Devaraj Urs Academy of Higher Education and Research, Kolar was started in the year 1986 by group of philanthropists and educationists. The team was headed by Shri. R.L.Jalappa, Founder chairman in the small hamlet, Tamaka, Kolar, Karnataka. The motive of starting this institution was to cater quality higher education to the backward classes. The institution was started with an intake of 100 undergraduate students and in a short span increased to 150 students. The beginning years itself the college has created a history by bagging 12 Gold Medals in the affiliated Bangalore University examination conferred in the year 1991. From that time, Sri Devaraj Urs Medical College has excelled in the higher education.

The Medical college has started its postgraduate courses from the year 1996 and at present has postgraduate programme in 19 departments. The college has applied for start of new courses in the departments of Emergency Medicine and Transfusion Medicine. Further, medical college in due course of time is applying for super specialty courses in Urology, Neurology, Plastic surgery and Cardiology.

Sri Devaraj Urs Medical College affiliated to Sri Devaraj Urs Academy of Higher Education and Research in the year 2007 has started Ph.D. programme in 8 departments and Fellowship programme in Head and Neck Oncology.

Medical College has a well-structured curriculum beyond the statutory body guidelines. This has enabled the students graduating from medical college to compete globally and become a competent doctor.

Medical College has a well-qualified faculty who are dedicated and competent in teaching, learning and evaluation. This has been proved year on year with the results and the student feedback. The competency, the students acquire from this institution has been applauded globally. The transparency in conduct of examination both in formative and summative assessments has been captured in the feedback form submitted by students and external examiners. Medical College has coterie of faculty who are pioneers in medical education headed by Dr. P. N. Sreeramulu, Principal as the Chairman. College has implemented CBME curriculum from the present batch and all the faculty are trained for the same.



Medical college has central formative assessment and evaluation system invigilation of formative assessment is also centralized at the college level. This has proved the transparency in the examination and evaluation system of our institution. College has implemented 100% Objective structured practical examination and Objective structured clinical examination in both formative and summative assessments.

Medical college has a well-equipped state-of-art Central Diagnostic Laboratory service, Central Research Laboratory and Center for Advanced Research and Excellence (CARE), where undergraduates, postgraduates, Ph.D. scholars, faculty and scientists can carry out their research activities. Department of Biochemistry has established Fluorosis Research Referral Laboratory (FRRL) to conduct research on fluorosis which is endemic in this area. FRRL is headed by Dr. K. N. Shashidhar, from Department of Biochemistry and supported by all the departments of Faculty of Medicine and Faculty of Allied Health and Basic Sciences. Department of Forensic Medicine in collaboration with the Department of Biochemistry has established Toxicology and Poison Detection Center (PDC).

From 1st April 2019 to 31st March 2020 college has published 194 research publications in peer reviewed, indexed journals with a good impact factor. Faculty of SDUMC was sanctioned 17 SDUAHER funded projects and research is in progress. Faculty and postgraduate students has presented research papers in National and International conferences.

Our institution has been continuously approved with STS ICMR projects for undergraduates and the number which was 02 in 2006 has increased to more than 54 in the current year. The postgraduate ICMR projects have also increased exponentially year on year.

With respect to infrastructure and learning resources, medical college has 6 lecture galleries with modern facilities to train the students in the health care delivery system. Institution has well equipped laboratories to train students in core competencies to prepare them to compete globally. Institution has a structured mentorship programme. The mentorship programme has helped the students to improve their student- teacher relationship and also mentor-mentee relationship. Thus, the students' attendance, performance in both academic and non-academic activities has improved beyond expectation. SDUMC has an in-house student counselor to address issues related to student relations. College has separate hostel facilities for boys and girls students with round the clock security and infrastructural facility. Residential facilities are available for teaching and non-teaching staff of medical college.

College has a Herbal garden with plants of medicinal importance and animal house for research activities.



Animal house is well equipped with suitable environmental condition for the animals and has an in-house veterinary office to take care of their health. Medical college has rainwater harvesting facility and facility for Divyaangan (physically challenged persons). Campus is filled with lush green environment with more than 3,000 trees of different families. Institution has natural apiculture due to the in-house horticulture.

Medical college is vibrant in conduct of various CMEs, Guest Lectures, Days of importance, Workshops, Melas, Birthday celebrations of National leaders and freedom fighters etc. Our institution has been encouraging the diversity of students by conducting festivals of State and National importance.

Students are encouraged to participate in sports and cultural activities at state and international level and have brought accolades to the institution.

Institution has governance, leadership and management at student, faculty as well as non-teaching staff. The students are included in the various committees and are given autonomous to carry out the activities related to sports, cultural, magazine, academic society, student welfare etc. However, the students are monitored and guided by the well experienced faculty.

The Institutional values are:

- ◆ On par with The Academy Vision and Mission statement and most of the short term goals have been achieved.
- ◆ The institution promotes the gender equity
- ◆ 24 x 7 security to students and faculty and an extra care towards female employees.
- ◆ Has in-house student counselor to take care of students psychological needs.
- ◆ Provision for separate boys and girls lounge.
- ◆ Has well equipped Crèche facility for kids of employees.
- ◆ To initiate go - green and save energy measures has solar geysers installed in all the hostels.
- ◆ Conduct Kannada classes for 1st year students to make them competent enough to converse with patients.
- ◆ To save water, institution has rain harvesting facility.
- ◆ To promote unity in diversity college conducts major festivals of all communities.
- ◆ In addition to regular teaching, learning and evaluation, the students are encouraged in cultural, sports and societal activities.
- ◆ Encourage faculty and Department by identifying the Best Teacher and Best Department respectively and award them.
- ◆ SDUMC has signed MoU to train UG students for entrance examination to join postgraduate MD / MS courses.
- ◆ As extension services and consultancy, SDUMC has entered in to MoU with Silver Crest Private Limited.
- ◆ Alumni association of SDUMC has donated study furniture to a Primary Govt. School at Marimakalahalli, a remote village in Chikkaballapur District.
- ◆ College has conducted online classes as per the schedule fixed at the beginning of the academic year and also the online assessments during COVID-19 crisis.

HOSPITAL REPORT



R. L. Jalappa Hospital and Research Centre is a 1200 bedded tertiary rural health care hospital attached to Sri Devaraj Urs Medical College a constituent of Sri Devaraj Urs Academy of Higher Education and Research serving an economically backward area. It provides comprehensive health care at affordable cost and is therefore a privilege to Kolar district and adjoining areas of neighbouring states. It aims to provide state of the art patient care complying with international standards and at the same time participates in high quality research thereby contributing to medical knowledge. This is the only centre providing super specialty services in this region and excels in emergency medical and surgical care particularly for complicated cases.

This hospital is a confluence of excellent patient care, high quality medical education and contemporary research. The Emergency medical services, Oncology treatment & care and other Super specialty services like Neurosurgery, Urology etc., are a boon to the population of this region benefitting a large number of patients. The hospital has a close tie up with Cell biology and Molecular Genetics department, Department of Audiology and Speech Pathology, Physiotherapy and Nutrition and Dietetics department which come under Allied Health Sciences faculty of this University and contribute to patient care and research.

- ◆ Talking about the challenges faced the biggest and the meanest challenge of all was the COVID-19 pandemic. When the whole world was fighting the COVID-19 pandemic it was our responsibility to prepare ourselves and join hands with the world in this fight. In response to the dire need to take the COVID-19 crisis of this region head on, the R.L. Jalappa Hospital & Research Centre took a series of measures to address the emerging burning issues and has been providing the best of services possible.
- ◆ When whole world was buzzing with the word 'CORONA' and the pandemic was gripping all around our region as Chikkaballapur, Bengaluru rural and cross border districts too it was 43 days later to declaration of COVID-19 as pandemic our district reported the first case and we were prepared for this battle by then.



- ◆ We started by conducting awareness programmes about the pandemic, a spectrum of training sessions, right from cough etiquettes and proper use of masks to use of ventilator strategy in the management of COVID-19 pandemic. The training was for in house employees and we also extended our sensitisation programmes, trainings on diagnosis of the disease, trainings on management of dead bodies and many more to the district administrative authorities, police officers & staff, district health care officers and many more.
- ◆ Our management stood with us by encouraging and supporting morally and financially to curb the disease spread by supplying face masks, face shields, hand sanitizers, high end diagnostic facilities and many more.
- ◆ Apart from earmarking 420 beds along with 34 ICU beds with 14 ventilators, BiPAP, HFNO facilities a dedicated team of expert doctors and paramedical personnel, supporting staffs have been at the forefront in the battle against COVID pandemic, going beyond the call of duty with zeal & dedication. In the process, some of our health workers got infected in spite of following guidelines to prevent cross infection. Notwithstanding this, our personnel are highly motivated and keen to be at the forefront in serving the community in this crisis.
- ◆ In a brisk and energetic effort the diagnostic facility (RTPCR and TrueNaat) has been boosted up by more than ten times from mere 20 tests per day. Today at our laboratories we are performing up to 300 tests a day. We have even extended our hands in helping the district authorities by providing laboratory diagnostic facilities for diagnosis of COVID-19 samples obtained throughout the district. Till date we have tested and provided results to beyond 13,000 samples requested by the district administrative authorities. (cost amounting to more than rupees 2 crores).
- ◆ By instituting a systematic screening protocol beyond 15,064 COVID-19 suspect cases have been screened and tested. As a tertiary care hospital, we have managed nearly 2000 (1965) suspected COVID-19 cases as inpatients till date of these 1173 are confirmed COVID-19 cases and the count is still on.
- ◆ HICC and NABH training for all the Teaching and Non-teaching staff was conducted between 11th May to 23rd May 2020 regarding hand hygiene, standard precautions, PPE, cough etiquette, HCAI definition and surveillance, cleaning and disinfection, CPR training, IPC measures for COVID-19 pandemic.



- ◆ Taking the COVID challenge head on our hospital started an integrated all-round care program for COVID-19 patients by enlisting supports from Aayush OPD, Yoga therapy and Physiotherapy.
- ◆ Quality department of RLJH & RC conducted NABH training for all doctors on 7th 8th & 10th Feb-2020.
- ◆ BD company conducted a training programme for all doctors on 25th February 2020 regarding hand hygiene, standard precautions HAI's (Health care Associated Infection), biomedical waste management, equipment & disinfection, prevention of NSI (Needle stick injury) at centre for Clinical Skills and Simulations.
- ◆ Our hospital started '**Comprehensive Integrated Geriatric Care**' along with speciality in **Geriatrics Palliative Care**.
- ◆ The Intensive Care Units have rendered top quality service in critically ill patients belonging to both Medical and Surgical specialties and have been the only centre in this region efficiently attending to Severe Acute Respiratory Illness Syndromes including the COVID-19 subjects thereby saving many precious lives.
- ◆ The Nephrology and Dialysis services have also been instrumental in saving many lives.
- ◆ The hospital takes pride in running post-doctoral fellowships in Head and Neck Onco surgery and Oral Onco surgery under the auspices of Sri Devaraj Urs Academy of Higher Education and Research.

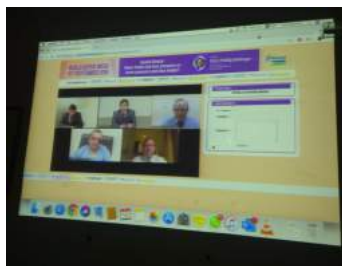

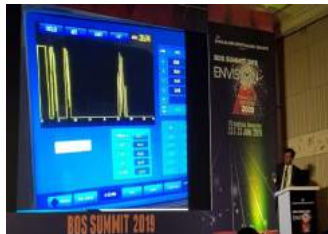

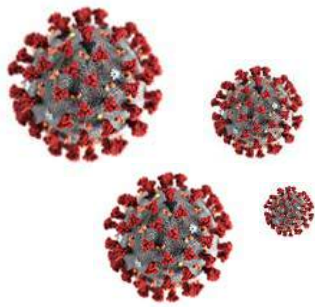

While I was on my research about love, I could see my friends in love.

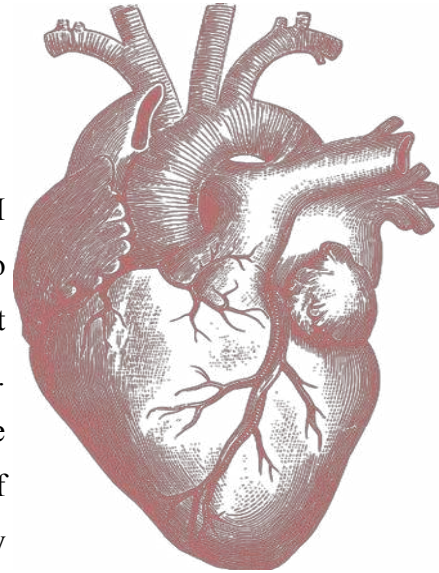
Love is truly magical.
