REPORT OF WORLD BLOOD DONATION DAY 2017

World Blood Donation Day is a globally celebrated event on 14th June every year to create general awareness about blood donation and its importance in saving countless precious lives. The event established in year 2004 serves to raise awareness of the need for safe Blood & blood products and to thank blood donors for their voluntary blood donation.

The theme of Blood Donation Day of current year has been "Don't wait until disaster strikes Give blood, Give now, Give often". The Youth Red Cross Unit of our university celebrated by organizing Blood Donation camp and awareness programme at R.L.Jalappa Hospital Tamaka Kolar.

Accordingly, 300 young students and other people from college and R L Jalappa hospital Tamaka Kolar, were chosen as the target group for blood donation and spreading awareness and motivating them to indulge in voluntary blood donation. The aim also included creation of inroads in the community through these young students to generate consciousness and alley fears about blood donation.
