COLLEGE REPORT





It is my great privilege to present the college report on the progress and achievements of our esteemed Sri Devaraj Urs Medical College, the achievements in academic, non-academic, research and publications and teaching learning evaluation during the academic year 2018-19.

Sri Devaraj Urs Medical College was started by Sri Devaraj Urs Educational Trust in the year 1986 and since 2007 is a constituent college under SDUAHER. The vision and mission of SDUMC are in accordance to those of the University and has objectives of ensuring highly qualified and motivated faculty, providing necessary infrastructure and facilities for students and staff and facilitating need based quality Medical Research.

Highly qualified and motivated faculty who are provided with necessary infrastructure and facilities for training and research with equally motivated and committed students strive hard to attain the objectives set by the institution to accomplish the mission of Quality health care.

The College offers MBBS course with 150 Annual Admissions, 18 departments offer PG degree course, 13 departments offer Ph.D. programmes. Totally 51 students have been enrolled for Ph.D., Dr. N. Krishna Sumanth, Dept. of Biochemistry were awarded with Ph.D during the year 2018. Till date SDUMC has produced 3918 MBBS Graduates, 573 PG Degree & Diploma holders. The Medical College has more than adequate qualified teaching and non-teaching staff to undertake teaching, training and service delivery.

The Medical College has infrastructure and learning resources which are periodically updated as per the needs of the students and faculty. The lecture galleries have been upgraded to smart class rooms and the University Library and Learning resource Centre consists of 28000 volumes of books, 11300 back volumes (journals) and 1165 compact discs (CD). The library subscribes to 56 foreign titles of current journals and 99 Indian journals.

A Modern Central Diagnostic Laboratory provides all necessary investigations for patient care and research. A State of the art Centre for Advanced Research and Excellence – CARE for clinical skills and simulation with simulators provides hands- on-training to all the undergraduates, PGs, Interns and faculty. 3 primary health centers are attached to the medical college of which Devaraya Samudra PHC is being adopted and complete administration is being done by the Dept. of Community Medicine. In addition, an Urban Health Centre and outreach clinics are being run by the Department of Community Medicine.





The college maintains high standard in Teaching, Training and Evaluation processes as evidenced by the high pass percentage with a substantial number of students securing Gold Medals/Distinctions/First Classes, in the University Examinations and is a testimony to the efforts of the dedicated faculty.

Fully integrated, innovative, curricula within the regulation of Medical Council of India have been prepared for the students to acquire adequate knowledge, requisite skills and competence. Students are also taught Medical Ethics, the Constitution of India and research in emerging areas of knowledge in each subject of study.

The college campus provides adequate and comfortable Hostel accommodation. There are five men's hostels with 536 students and with 736 capacity, five ladies hostels with 642 students and with 875 students' capacity. The canteens, cafeteria, bakery, consumer co-operative society, laundry, ATM and other such facilities to take care of day-to-day needs of the students and staff. The staff is provided with in-campus accommodation and their presence in the campus creates a homely atmosphere. Various guest houses accommodate visiting dignitaries, examiners, parents and Alumni of our institution. Alumni and Parent-Teacher Associations are active with their valuable suggestions.

The inmates are protected round the clock by vigilant security personnel. The college offers unique professional, cultural and recreational opportunities in a serene and cordial environment. The hallmark of the college is the excellent discipline and moral values inculcated among the students.

A fully equipped modern gymnasium, synthetic tennis court, indoor sports facility, basketball court, playground and athletic grounds meet the extracurricular activities of the students. Annual intercollege and intra collegiate level sports and athletic meets are held on regular basis.

For the working professionals, a crèche facility is also available within the campus which has trained personnel for the care of the children.

During the year 2018 various departments of the Medical College conducted several professional enhancement activities including Continuing Medical Education programmes, Conferences, Symposia, Workshops and Seminars. The faculty members have published over 118 publications in various reputed and indexed journals.

The Dept. of Pathology has conducted IAC-KC-CON-2018 Annual State Conference on "Cytology Update" (In association with Indian Academy of Cytologists – Karnataka Chapter) in collaboration with ICMR & MET on 2nd & 3rd March 2018.

The Dept. of Integrative Medicine & Dept. of Medicine has conducted National conference 'SAMANVAYA – 2018 on 29th June 2018.

The students are also encouraged to participate in research activities. Till date our institution has been sanctioned 72 STS ICMR Projects and around 8 PG ICMR funding. Under graduate and Post Graduate Students are encouraged to convert research into publications. Faculty are encouraged by granting seed grants by our Academy.

Various health events of importance are conducted by involving students as outreach activity and orient students regarding community awareness by having a community oriented approach.



HOSPITAL REPORT





R.L.Jalappa Hospital and Research Centre is a Teaching Hospital attached to Sri Devaraj Urs Medical College, which is the Constituent Institution of Sri Devaraj Urs Academy of Higher Education and Research. Ours is a tertiary referral Health Care Centre started in the year 1994 with out-patient service and has grown up to the present state of art quality health care delivery system. Our hospital is catering to the Health care needs of Kolar and Chikkaballapur district and also the adjoining areas of Andhra Pradesh and Tamil Nadu.

The newer additions to our R.L.Jalappa Hospital and Research Centre in the year 2018-19 include

• State of the Art Critical Care Centre was added in October 2018, with 36 bedded ICU, 12 modular OTs, 22 Hemodialysis machines and endoscopy services. 

In the aftermath of the recent Pulwama attack it felt like both nations were once again perched on the precipice of an erupting war. Hysteria grasps the masses faster than a bout of cholera. And the shrill war cry for a bloodbath echoes louder than ever (#PKMKB). However, we miss two key points of the situation; firstly, neither nations are in any state, not financially, nor politically to be involved in a war. Secondly, all caps opinions of an everyday "twitterati" demanding a trial at arms does not make for appropriate counsel to the defence ministry.

As of now, it is a huge sigh of relief to see the heat hasn't reached the head, or rather, the "heads of state" and even at the heights of tension, both convoys of ministries, despite their power-packed speeches, haven't taken any rash steps. *Yet.* Neither history nor reality of war between India and Pakistan reveal a pretty future- it would set back years of diplomatic relations and economic growth, lead to loss of innumerable soldiers, paramilitary personnel and civilians, incur severe financial loss in both countries. Lest we not forget that both countries are nuclear powers and make this war an apocalyptic event for the population of both nations and the global geopolitical implications would not only make it to be a spectator sport of bloodshed but would also polarize international support across the world. India shares approximately 15,000km of international land and 7,000km of international sea border as its territory; concentrating our forces in one specific landmass leaves precious key locations barren and open for attack.

Coming to the PUBG angle, having less to do with the game and more to do with the players itself, it is evident that most of the active players are members of our own generation. Ours is a generation formed largely of smart phone wielding millennials and Gen-Ys who have never actually lived through a war in our lifetimes. Be it in our sheer ignorance or inexperience, all relevance we have with the act of war is not from lived experiences but from fanciful depictions from movies or playing a close game of PUBG. In emotions of hyper nationalism and arrogance we thrive on our quest for revenge, putting in risk the lives of the same soldiers we claim to love, while remaining safely sequestered in our respective homes.

In the aftermath of the Indian pilot being captured in Pakistani soil, the focus shifted from a hyperbolic quest for bloodbath to ensuring the safe return of our pilot. This brush with reality served as a quick preview to the price tag of war- is our generation really ready to martyr lives in our thirst for revenge? Are we ready to lose our men to the other side as prisoners or to death? Are we really ready to curtail individual freedom and live in a situation of fear and gamble on victory?

Bottom line is, there is neither valour nor victor after a war, only the side that remains. India, in all its history has never been an initiator or aggressor in matters of war. Hope we don't start now.
