
Event Report: "Goodbye Ragging" - Anti Ragging Sensitization Program

Dr. Ajay Kumar TS, Warden, Men's Hostel and Nodal Person, Antiragging Cell, SDUAHER welcomed the gathering.








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Following competitions were organized as a part of **Antiragging Week – 2023**:
