2.	<p>Background / introductions: During the second year of MBBS program, students actively take part in eliciting patient's history, physical examination and correlation of investigations with clinical features to arrive at a diagnosis. It is important to orient these students to the various clinical skills and Medical ethics. Therefore this program is scheduled at the beginning of second MBBS.</p>

5.	<p>Event report</p> <p>The Medical Education Unit, Sri Devaraj Urs Medical college, Kolar conducted an orientation program for the II MBBS students (2022-23 batch) on 5th January 2024 from 09.00 am to 01.00pm in the A V.Hall, adjacent to Physiology department, SDUMC, under the guidance of</p> <p>Dr. T.N.Suresh, MEU Convener. Dr.Geetha.S, Professor of Physiology, was the organizing secretary.</p> <p>The program started with a rendition of an invocation song by Ms.Mridula of II MBBS. This was followed by the welcome address by Dr. Suresh T.N.</p> <p>Dr.Prabhakar, K, Dean and Principal, SDUMC gave a bird's eye view of the II MBBS course. He mentioned the subjects of II MBBS and their assessment patterns. He emphasized the importance of attendance and reiterated the need for the right attitude, dress code and punctuality by the students.</p> <p>He also discussed the science and the art of history taking. He stressed the importance of developing the skill of eliciting history from the patient and the need and appropriateness of the components of history taking.</p> <p>Dr.Shashirekha, HoD & Professor of General Surgery spoke on the art and science of general physical examination, which would follow history taking from a patient. She elaborated on the need for general physical examination and the tools required and the techniques of performing a general physical examination.</p> <p>A ten minute tea break was announced and tea was served to all the students and resource persons outside the AV hall.</p>

	<p>Post tea break, Dr.Mohan Reddy, HoD of Psychiatry, elaborated on the behavioral and communication skills required while communicating with the patients to aid in the arrival of a correct diagnosis. He spoke about the different means of communication and the importance of listening and also about developing the right attitude and body language which would aid in building a rapport with the patients, who would then give the right history to the examining doctor.</p> <p>Dr.Prakash Dave, Professor of General Surgery, spoke about the elements of medical ethics. He discussed about bioethics and medical ethics and the principles of medical ethics with the aid of clinical case examples.</p> <p>Dr.Sudha Reddy, HoD of Paediatrics elaborated on the learner doctor method of clinical training. She oriented the students towards the timings of the program, activities involved and their documentation and assessment of the skills acquired during this program. She also spoke on the importance of maintaining a log book.</p>
