The Department of Emergency Medicine is happy to inform you that we are conducting a 'Value added course' on "Trauma Life support".

Trauma remains the leading cause of death and disability in children and young adults. The incidence and prevalence of poly trauma varies from region to region. Poly trauma patients represent the ultimate challenge to Trauma Care and usually die within first hour following Trauma, often defined as "The Golden Hour of Trauma". Following the principle of "Time is Essence", management during the first hour of injury is essential. The mission of a Trauma team is to enlist the problems, establish priorities, stabilize the patient and finally transfer the patient under the specialized care of the team.

Objectives of the Course:

The "SDUMC Trauma Life Support" course provides it learners with a safe and reliable method for the treatment of the injured patients and basic knowledge necessary to

1. Assess a patient's condition rapidly and accurately.
2. Resuscitate and stabilize patient according to priority.
3. Determine whether a patient's needs exceeds facility resources.
4. Arrange appropriate patient transfers.
5. Ensure that optimal care provided and that the level of care does not deteriorate at any point during the evaluation, resuscitation or transfer process.

Target Audience: Interns and Postgraduates of Medical and AHS students.

Course Duration: 30 hours

Attendance: for all the session is mandatory for successful completion of the course.
