Rules for the e-Poster Competition

Theme:“Communicable Diseases- causes, symptoms, lab diagnosis, symptoms and Prevention”

1. One e-Poster per 5 participant.
2. 10 groups will be allowed to participate from each school.

3. e-Poster to be done under given template and final poster to be converted to PDF and presented through laptop. Students can use table's images, graphs from internet and make it more creative. (e-Poster Template will be provided by organizers through whats app and Laptop will be provided by organizers on the day of presentation.)
4. Rules of Poster presentation

- Each group will be allotted 3 mins for presentation, 2 min for discussion and question and answer session by judges and audience.

5. All the participants will be awarded with certificate of participation.
 6. The best three e-Posters will be awarded first, second and third prize.
