WHAT IS CERVICAL CANCER?

Cervical cancer is a preventable and treatable cancer that occurs in the cells of the cervix. It is mainly caused by persistent infection with high-risk strains of the Human Papillomavirus.

WHY IS SCREENING IMPORTANT?

- Early detection prevents progression to cancer.
- Cervical cancer is one of the most preventable cancers.
- Screening detects pre-cancerous changes and allows for timely intervention.

WHO SHOULD GET SCREENED?

• All women aged 21-65 years.

SCREENING TESTS AVAILABLE

- 1. Pap Smear (Papanicolaou Test)
- 2. HPV Test
- 3. Co-Testing (Pap Smear + HPV Test)

SYMPTOMS OF CERVICAL CANCER

- Abnormal vaginal bleeding
- Unusual vaginal discharge.
- Pelvic pain or pain during intercourse.

HPV VACCINATION: AN ADDED PROTECTION

- Recommended for girls and women aged 9-26 years.
- Protects against high-risk HPV types that cause 70% of cervical cancers.

Visit your nearest gynecology government hospital, primary health center, or for screening.
