Overview of Activities and Sessions




Fig 1- Students appearing for the preliminary MCQ round held on April 2, 2025.




Figure 2: Dr. Roshini Reddy and Dr. Muthamil welcoming the audience and anchoring the event.




Fig 5- Award ceremony for the First Runner up of the quiz competition.




Fig 6- Award ceremony for the second runner up of the quiz competition




Figure 8: Dr. Sunil B.N., Organizing Chairman and In-Charge HOD of Community Medicine, being felicitated by the dignitaries.

Dr. Sunil was honored for his exemplary leadership and efforts in successfully organizing the World Health Day event and the IAPSM Quiz Competition.




Fig. 9, Dr. Chanditha Krishna Reddy giving vote of thanks.
