Trauma remains the leading cause of death and disability among children and young adults, presenting significant challenges to healthcare systems around the world. Polytrauma represents one of the most challenging and urgent situations in trauma care. The Golden Hour is a critical period during which timely and effective intervention can dramatically improve patient outcomes. Trauma teams must act swiftly and decisively, utilizing their expertise to stabilize patients, prioritize care, and transfer them to specialized facilities for further treatment. The management of polytrauma requires a team approach, rapid decision-making, and a deep understanding of the complexities involved in caring for critically injured patients.

Objectives of the Course:

The “**Emergency Trauma Care and Resuscitation Training**” course provides it learners with a safe and reliable method for the treatment of the injured patients and basic knowledge necessary to

1. Assess a patient’s condition rapidly and accurately.
2. Resuscitate and stabilize patient according to priority.
3. Determine whether a patient’s needs exceeds facility resources.
4. Arrange appropriate patient transfers.
5. Ensure that optimal care provided and that the level of care does not deteriorate at any point during the evaluation, resuscitation or transfer process.
