ADMISSION TO POSTGRADUATE (2025-26)

Sri Devaraj Urs Medical College, situated in Kolar, Karnataka, is affiliated with Sri Devaraj Urs Academy of Higher Education and Research, recognized as a deemed-to-be University. Since its inception in 1986, the college has been offering postgraduate programs in Medical and Surgical Specialties.



The College has 23 departments which offer postgraduate degree in Broad Specialties (MD/MS/DNB), Super Specialties in addition to MBBS Undergraduate program and seven departments run Ph.D. programs with 3 interdisciplinary Ph.D. programs. Currently there are **175 postgraduate seats** in various disciplines.

R L Jalappa Hospital and Research Centre, the teaching hospital of the medical college was established in 1994 with the objective of providing accessible, high-quality healthcare services to the residents of Kolar and neighboring districts of Karnataka, Tamil Nadu and Andhra Pradesh. The primary goal of the hospital is to ensure that patients receive excellent medical care in their local community, emphasizing affordability and proximity to their homes.

Today R L Jalappa Hospital and Research Centre is a 1200 bedded well equipped tertiary care multispecialty hospital and has 36 bedded state of the art well equipped intensive care Unit (ICU), 20 bedded cardiac critical care Unit (CCU). The Hospital is attached to Sri Devaraj Urs Medical College, a constituent unit of Sri Devaraj Urs Academy of Higher Education and Research catering to the population of economically backward area. It aims to provide high end tertiary health care complying with global standards at an affordable cost and at the same time join hands to conduct high quality healthcare research thereby contributing to medical science.

R L Jalappa Hospital and Research Center stands out as the exclusive healthcare facility in the region to have earned accreditation from NABL (National Accreditation Board for Testing and Calibration Laboratories) and NABH (National Accreditation Board for Hospitals and Healthcare Providers). This recognition reaffirms the hospital's commitment to maintaining exceptional quality standards and providing exemplary healthcare services to the community

The Hospital is the only center providing super specialty services in various health care in this region and stands out in emergency medical and surgical care particularly for life threatening, complicated high-risk cases and pandemic outbreaks

R L Jalappa Hospital and Research Center takes its pride in having qualified, competent and experienced Doctors, Nurses and other skilled staff, all working collaboratively to provide exceptional healthcare services. The hospital provides affordable, inclusive, and integrated approach to quality healthcare by including the services from Department of Cell biology and Molecular Genetics, Department of Speech Pathology and Audiology, Department of Physiotherapy, Department of Integrated Medicine and Department of Nutrition & Dietetics which comes under Allied Health Sciences of this University contributing to treatment of patient and research. The hospital has a MoU with Narayana Hrudayalaya, Bengaluru for managing cardiac cases.

The state of Heart Critical Care Units and Operation theatres of the hospital have rendered top quality service to critically ill patients and has been the only center in this region attending to emergency and other illnesses efficiently thereby, saving many precious lives.

The Nephrology and Dialysis services block has 22 dialysis units and is treating patients with end stage renal diseases thereby saving many lives.

The Medical College also runs its own Primary Health care facility runs an Urban Health Training Centre in Kolar town and a Rural Health Training Centre. Family adoption program is being conducted successfully and all elements of competency based medical education are delivered in a well-structured curriculum.

Various health awareness events of importance are conducted regularly, by involving students as outreach activity. This community oriented approach helps the students obtain first-hand information on the health issues of the community and create awareness among them. The students are regularly posted to health camps where they are interact with the patients and their relatives in a compassionate manner under the guidance of the faculty. During these sessions they develop team building skills and learn to work in a health care team. This is the only Hospital in the entire district and surrounding areas involved in highly specialized oncology services which includes early cancer detection and comprehensive management by the team of Medical, Surgical and Radiation Oncologist.

I Admission Procedure

Eligibility for admission to Postgraduate courses:

a) NEET-PG 2025 Performance:

- Candidates must have appeared for the NEET-PG 2025 and must have qualified in the NEET-PG 2025 for admission to MD/MS/DNB Courses.

b) Candidates applying under NRI category are advised to go through the NRI chapter carefully

NRI CHAPTER

REVISED GUIDELINES FOR ISSUE OF NRI CERTIFICATE BY EMBASSIES/HIGH COMMISSIONS/CONSULATES OF INDIA ABROAD dated 30th July, 2025 issued by Ministry of External Affairs (MEA), the updated list of mandatory documents for NRI quota are as follows:

- NEET-PG Admit Card and Score Card
- Proof of NRI Status of the parent/relative:
 - Valid Passport
 - Visa / Residence Permit / Work Permit
- Overseas Citizen of India (OCI) card / PIO card, if applicable
- NRI Certificate issued by the Competent Authority (Embassy / Indian Consulate).
- Certificate of Relationship between the NRI relative and the candidate issued by the competent Revenue Authority through Family Tree.
- Affidavit (Notarized) by the NRI relative stating that they will sponsor the entire course fee and living expenses of the candidate during the period of study duly supported by NRE (Non-Resident External) Bank Account Pass Book.
- 10th & 12th mark sheets + passing certificate
- Birth certificate
- Passport of candidate/ Sponsorer (optional)

Candidates who want to fill NRI choices are required to send above stated documents on email Id nri.adgmemcc1@gmail.com as and when Notice is published on MCC website (www.mcc.nic.in) before each round of counselling. The documents sent by candidates will be scrutinized by MCC and those who are found eligible for NRI quota will be shown choices of NRI seats.

The allotment of seats under the NRI Category will be conducted based on the following priority system:

- Priority 1:
 - NRI Candidates
 - Children of NRIs
- Priority 2:
 - **First-degree relatives of NRI wards.**
 - Real brother and sister of father i.e. real uncle and real aunt.
 - Real brother and sister of mother i.e. real maternal uncle and maternal aunt.
 - Father and mother of father i.e. grandfather and grandmother.
 - Father and mother of mother i.e. maternal grandfather and maternal grandmother.

▪ **Second-degree relatives of NRI wards.**

v) First degree-paternal and maternal cousins

The allotment process will be carried out in sequential order, giving preference to Priority 1 candidates first, followed by Priority 2 candidates, subject to seat availability.

c) **DIPLOMATE OF NATIONAL BOARD (DNB)**

- The Counselling for In-service seats of DNB is not conducted by MCC of DGHS, MoHFW.
- There will be four rounds of counseling i.e. Round 1, Round 2, Round 3 & Stray Vacancy Round which will be conducted by MCC.
- All the candidates who have qualified NEET PG conducted by NBE will be eligible.

d) Selection Process:

- Admission will be granted based on NEET-PG 2025 scores within the respective categories.

e) Additional Information:

- There shall be no reservation for OBC/SC/ST/PWD/EWS candidates in deemed to be universities as per MCC.
- For all other eligibility conditions, the website of the National Medical Commission, New Delhi may be referred.

Counseling Process by MCC:

- **National Counseling:** All 100% of seats of deemed universities will be filled through National-level online counseling by the Medical Counseling Committee (MCC) of DGHS, New Delhi.
- **Counseling Rounds:** There are four rounds - Round 1, Round 2, Round 3, and Stray Vacancy Round. All rounds will be conducted through online by the MCC as per schedule of counseling.
- **Registration:** To become eligible for allotment of a seat, candidates are required to register on the MCC website: www.mcc.nic.in. Keep checking the site for updates and counseling schedules.

After Allotment:

- **Reporting:** Candidates after getting an online provisional allotment order from MCC, must report to the Institute along with the order. Pay the entire tuition fee and admission charges fee for the year 2025-26 prior to reporting to the Institute Physically within the stipulated time as per MCC Counselling Schedule.
- **Documents:** Candidates must bring all original certificates along with 3 sets of self-attested photo copies to the institute.

The amount of fee to be deducted in case candidate resigns after counseling period /cutoff date:

Where any student discontinues from the PG (MD/MS/DNB) course after admission for any reason, either on or after the cut-off date prescribed by the statutory and/or University authorities for admission to the first year of the course, or where the seat is rendered vacant without having any chance of being filled up with any other candidate, such students will have to remit the tuition fee and other applicable fees for the 'entire/ remaining duration of course period'.

V General Information:

- If you provide false information or fake documents, your admission will be cancelled, fees will not be returned, and you could face legal action.
- If you receive a provisional allotment letter, please submit all required documents to the institute along with payment of fees within the scheduled time. Don't wait

Until the last minute, as document verification and admission processes take time.

- You must report in person on the date and time given by the MCC in your allotment order. Bring all original documents and make sure your tuition fee payment is complete.
- If your original documents are with another institution, you need to retrieve them. Admission will not be completed if you only bring a certificate stating your documents are elsewhere.
- Once admitted, you must follow the university's rules regarding the syllabus, exams, fees, and conduct.
- The university can change any rules to comply with official regulations from time to time.
- You must pay all tuition and other fees by the due dates in the coming years. If you don't, your name will be removed from the college rolls.
- You must be present yourself for counseling and admission. No one else can represent you.
- Any disputes about these rules will be decided by the Vice Chancellor, and their decision is final.
- Try not to take long leave and aim to finish your course on time. Completion of three years Residency from the date of Reporting is Mandatory as per the NMC.
- Your name and date of birth will be registered as in your certificate of qualifying exam passed. No changes will be allowed later, so check these details carefully during admission.
