EMERGENCY MEDICINE DAY & EMS WEEK 2026

Emergency Medicine Day is observed annually on 27th May initiated by the International Federation for Emergency Medicine (IFEM) to promote Global awareness about the importance of effective emergency care systems. The day recognizes the crucial role of emergency physicians, nurses, Allied Healthcare Professionals as first responders who provide rapid assessment, resuscitation, and life-saving interventions during critical situations such as trauma, cardiac arrest, stroke, poisoning, obstetric emergencies, and pediatric emergencies.

EMS (Emergency Medical Services) Week is celebrated every year to honor Emergency Medical Technicians (EMTs), ambulance personnel, and all pre-hospital care providers. Organizations such as the National Association of Emergency Medical Technicians (NAEMT) support this observance globally to recognize the dedication of EMS professionals who serve as the first link in the **“Chain of Survival,”** by providing essential care during the **Golden Hour.**

The theme for EMS Week 2026 is **“Improving Outcomes, Together,”** emphasizes teamwork, collaboration, and the shared responsibility of healthcare providers and communities in delivering timely and effective emergency care.

Celebrating this kind of event/s in Higher Educational Institutions enhances student awareness, strengthens practical skills through Cardiac Pulmonary Resuscitation (CPR) and emergency simulations in Centre for Skill and Simulations. It reinforces the commitment to building competent emergency care professionals guided by the principle to promotes community engagement.

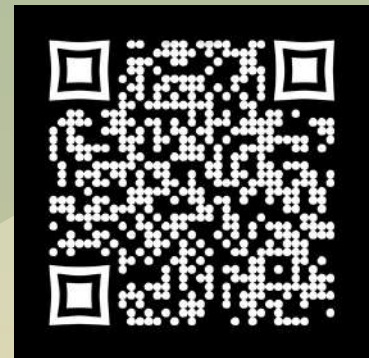
