Memorandum of Understanding

This Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) is made and entered into on 31st January 2025 in Delhi, India.

Between

THE UNIVERSITY GRANTS COMMISSION (herein after referred to as "UGC") having its registered office at Bahadur Shah Zafar Marg, New Delhi-110 002 which expression shall unless the context otherwise specifies or requires, mean and include its successors (the first Party).

SRI DEVARAJ URS ACADEMY OF HIGHER EDUCATION AND RESEARCH, Kolar having its office at **TAMAKA, KOLAR-563 103, KARNATAKA**, (herein after referred to as “SDUAHER”) which expression shall unless the context otherwise specifies or requires, mean and include its successors (the Second Party).

UGC and SDUAHER are individually referred to individually as “**PARTY**” and collectively as the “**PARTIES**”.

WHEREAS:

- I. The UGC through National Testing Agency (NTA) conducts an Eligibility Test namely, National Eligibility Test (NET) for the award of Junior Research Fellowship (JRF), for appointment as Assistant Professor in various subjects and for admission to Ph.D. programmes. The UGC-NET is held twice a year usually in June and December.
- II. The second party intends to utilize UGC-NET scores for admission to Ph.D.

The first party agrees to the request of the second party and a separate MoU will be made for each session of UGC-NET/Joint CSIR-UGC NET.

NOW THIS MOU WITNESSETH AS UNDER:

- a) The first party agrees to share the UGC- NET score to the second party which the second party shall use for admission to Ph.D.
- b) Personal details of the candidates, like addresses, phone numbers, or any other personal details, will not be shared.
- c) Details, i.e., Roll number, name, photograph, signature, names of the father and mother, gender, category, marks secured by the candidate, qualifying status of the candidates, and other relevant details can be shared.
- d) The second party shall comply with the provisions of Digital Personal Data Protection Act, 2023 and pertinent data privacy laws and regulations mandated by the Government of India and the Regulator(s) from time to time.
- e) The data will be shared as filled by the candidate and on an ‘as is where is basis, and the first party will not be responsible for the outcomes of the processes based on the information provided by the first party.



- f) The data will be shared in a pen drive, through email or through any other suitable online method.
- g) The data shall be used by the second party only for the stated purpose and will not be shared with any other person or entity.
- h) The second party shall not interfere with the policies for the conduct of UGC-NET, including syllabi, format, the pattern of examination, etc.
- i) It shall be the sole responsibility of the second party to verify the authenticity of the information provided by the candidates.
- j) The first party shall have the right to enter into or terminate an agreement to extend the UGC-NET score facility solely based on its discretion and judgement, without having to assign a reason for the decision.
- k) This memorandum can be amended or modified at any time during its term and shall not be amended except in writing.
- l) All correspondence will be addressed to the Secretary, University Grants Commission, Bahadur Shah Zafar Marg, New Delhi-110 002.
- m) This Memorandum shall be for the June/December 2024 UGC-NET / Joint CSIR- UGC NET for the following subject(s):
1. Life Sciences
 2. Yoga
 3. Ayurveda Biology
- n) Either Party may terminate this MoU by providing the other party with prior written notice of 30 days. In the event of any Party failing to fulfil its obligations as contemplated under this MoU, the other Party will notify in writing to cure such breach within 60 days, failing which this MoU shall be terminated forthwith at the option of the notifying Party.
- o) The first party bears no responsibility for any legal complications or litigation that may arise concerning the suitability and eligibility of a candidate for admission. The outcome of the UGC-NET is contingent upon the information provided by the Candidate in their application. It is incumbent upon the second party to diligently assess and confirm the eligibility of the candidate during the admission process. The data is provided exactly as it is received from the National Testing Agency (NTA).
- p) In case of any dispute or difference arising out of the or in relation to this Memorandum, the parties shall promptly and in good faith refer the same to their senior officials with a view to its amicable resolution and settlement. In case the parties are not able to resolve the dispute within 90 days, the same shall be referred to Arbitration in accordance with the provisions of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996.



The parties agree that the decision of the Arbitrator so appointed shall be final and binding upon the parties. The venue for the Arbitration shall be at New Delhi, India and the language used in the arbitral proceedings shall be English.
