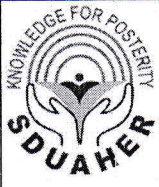

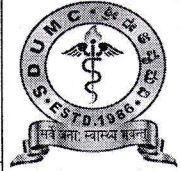




For the second-year MBBS students, MARROW organized a lively quiz competition with attractive prizes for the winners, making the session not only informative but also highly engaging and enjoyable.
