Dr Prabhakar K, Principal of SDUMC in his address stressed upon the challenges and qualities required to be a Successful Doctor in the Medical Field.



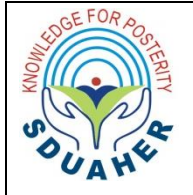

REPORT OF REGIONAL LEVEL CME ON ADOLESCENT MENTAL HEALTH CHALLENGES AND STRATEGIES held on 20-09-2024

Department of Community Medicine had organized a one day regional level CME on 'ADOLESCENT MENTAL HEALTH CHALLENGES AND STRATEGIES' at Sri Devaraj Urs Medical college, Sri Devaraj Urs University (SDUAHER) , Kolar, Karnataka. The official proceedings of the CME program were inaugurated by Dr. Prasanna Kamath B T, Head of the Department of Community Medicine at SDUMC, SDUAHER, at around 10:30 AM. This significant event set the stage for a thought-provoking gathering, emphasizing the pressing need to address adolescent mental health. Following the inauguration, we had the honor of hearing from our esteemed dignitaries. The Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor, Dr. B. Vengamma, along with Principal Dr. Prabhakar K, Principal SDUMC, SDUAHER, delivered a presidential address that underscored the importance of the CME topic: "Adolescent Mental Health Challenges and Strategies." Their insights laid a strong foundation for the discussions that followed, highlighting the urgency of this critical issue in today's society.

The CME was conducted in hybrid mode, A total of 115 participant joined via the Zoom meeting and 200 attended the programme, and total of 315 participants were registered for the CME.

Session-1: Dr.Ruth Sneha, Associate Professor, Department of Psychiatry, SDUMC, SDUAHER Kolar, commenced the first session on the topic “Can we recognise anxiety and depression in children at 11.00am

Chairperson: Dr.Vishwas.S, Associate Professor Department of Community Medicine.

Dr. Ruth Sneha addressed the problem of children under the following patterns: anxiety and depression can be recognized in children, although they may present differently than in adults. Common signs include changes in mood, such as persistent sadness, irritability, or mood swings, along with behavioural changes like withdrawal from friends, loss of interest in activities, or shifts in academic performance. She said that physical symptoms often manifest as complaints of headaches, stomach aches, or other unexplained ailments. Additionally, sleep and appetite changes, including insomnia, nightmares, or altered eating habits, are prevalent. Children may also exhibit excessive worry, with frequent fears about various situations that can lead to avoidance behaviours. She concluded early recognition and intervention are crucial for effective support and treatment, as addressing these signs promptly can significantly improve a child's emotional well-being and overall development.

Session 2 at 11:45 AM with Dr. Subramanyam, a consultant psychiatrist at East Point Medical College in Bangalore, who addressed the crucial links between child development, child psychiatry, and their implications for the teaching profession.

The session was chaired by Dr. Mohan Reddy, Professor and Head of the Department of Psychiatry.

Dr. Subramanyam highlighted the significance of social-emotional development, emphasizing that understanding social skills and emotional regulation can help teachers cultivate a supportive classroom environment. He pointed out the importance of early recognition of mental health issues, noting that educators trained in child psychiatry can identify signs of distress early, which facilitates timely intervention and support.

He also discussed the benefits of collaboration between educators and mental health professionals, advocating for the creation of individualized education plans (IEPs) that address the specific needs of students. Dr. Subramanyam stressed the necessity of developing inclusive learning environments, explaining that awareness of diverse learning needs enables teachers to adapt their methods to accommodate various learning styles and challenges.

Furthermore, he emphasized that knowledge of child development enhances teacher-student relationships by fostering empathy and trust. Engaging families was another key point, as he noted that a better understanding of children's developmental and psychological needs can improve communication between parents and teachers, leading to a more collaborative support system. Finally, Dr. Subramanyam encouraged ongoing professional development in child development and mental health, underscoring that continuous learning helps educators stay informed about best practices and emerging research, ultimately benefiting their students.

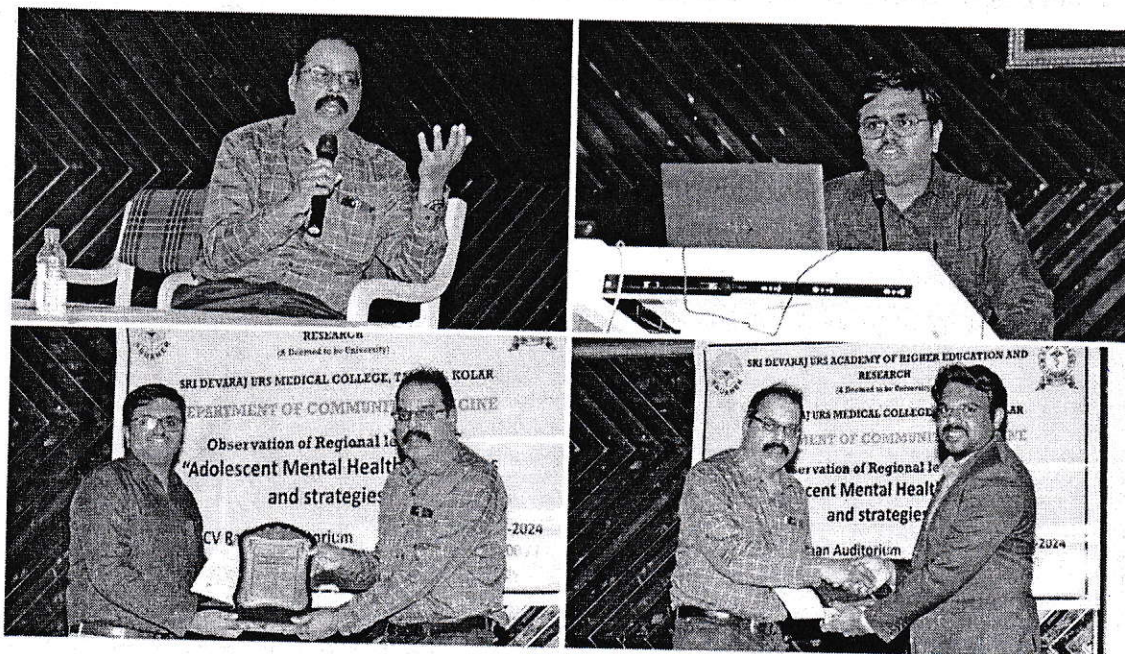


Fig3: (3a) Dr Mohan reddy, chairperson delivering his speech (3b) : Dr Subramanyam delivering his Speech; (3c) Dr Mohan reddy presenting memento to Dr Subramanyam; (3d) Dr Vivek Jayan presenting memento to Dr Mohan reddy

Session 3: Caught in the Web: Understanding Behavioral Addictions in the Digital Age," began in the afternoon at 1:45 PM and featured Dr. Lakshmi Sravanti, Assistant Professor in the Department of Child & Adolescent Psychiatry at NIMHANS, Bengaluru, India.

The session was chaired by Dr. Sahana S. Murthy, Assistant Professor of Psychiatry at SDUMC.

Dr. Sravanti began by explaining that behavioral addictions involve an uncontrollable urge to engage in certain behaviors despite the negative consequences that may arise. These addictions often trigger the brain's reward systems in a manner similar to substance abuse. She highlighted how digital addictions, in particular, are fueled by the release of dopamine, driven by constant rewards such as likes, achievements, and virtual wins, which reinforce the addictive behaviors.

The concept of instant gratification was another key point, as Dr. Sravanti noted that the internet provides immediate feedback and rewards, conditioning the brain to anticipate rapid satisfaction. She discussed the significant impact of prolonged exposure to addictive digital environments, which can lead to mental health issues such as anxiety, depression, attention deficits, and social isolation. Withdrawal symptoms, including irritability, restlessness, and discomfort, often occur when individuals are unable to access their digital platforms.

In terms of treatment and interventions, Dr. Sravanti emphasized the role of cognitive-behavioral therapy (CBT) in addressing behavioral addictions. She concluded saying that this therapeutic approach helps individuals recognize and modify problematic behaviors, aiming to restore balance and well-being in their lives.

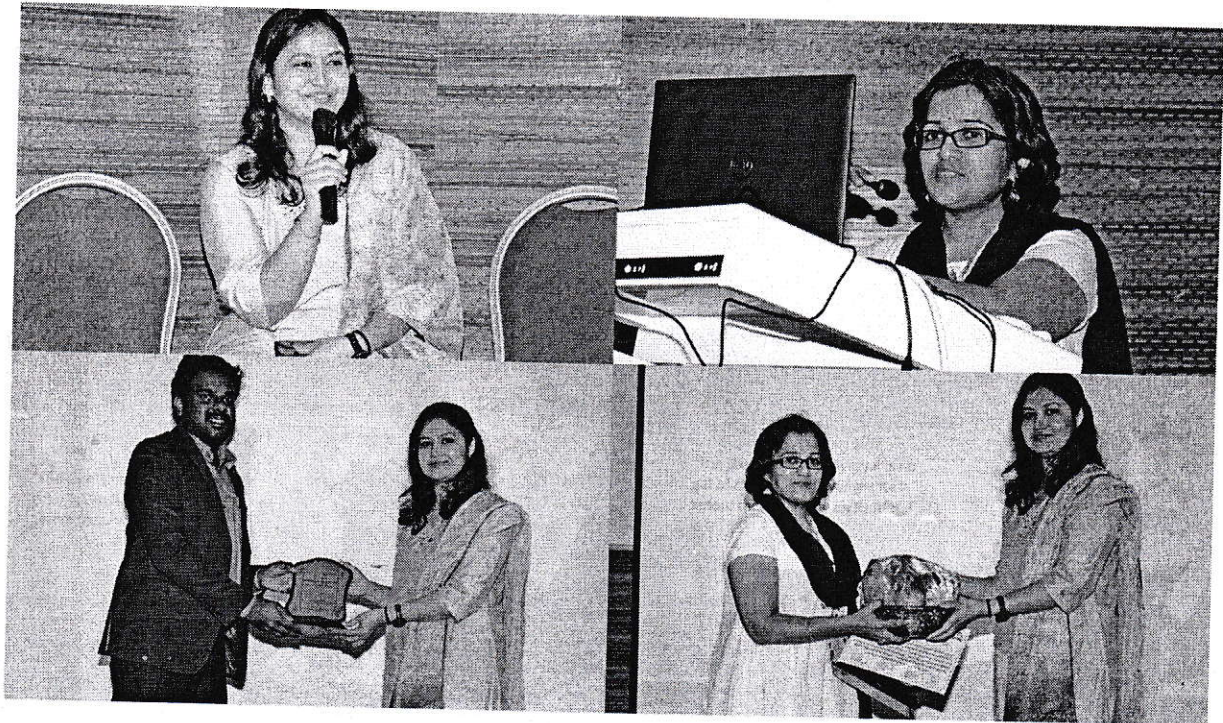


Fig4: (4a) Dr Sahana S Murthy chairperson delivering her speech; (4b): Dr Lakshmi Sravanti speaker delivering her Speech; (4c) Dr Vivek Jayan presenting memento to Dr Sahana S Murthy; (4d): Dr Sahana presenting memento to Dr Lakshmi

Session 4: "Parenting Styles and Their Impact on Child Development" began at 2:45 PM and featured Dr. A. Purushotham, Associate Professor of Psychiatry at SDUMC.

Chairperson: Dr.Sindhu Shankar S, Senior resident, KIMS, Bangalore

Dr. Purushotham's insightful session on "Parenting Styles and Their Impact on Child Development" focused on how different approaches to parenting shape children's growth, behavior, and emotional well-being. He categorized parenting into four styles: authoritarian, authoritative, permissive, and neglectful.

He said that the Authoritarian parenting will be characterized by strict rules and high expectations, may lead to obedient but anxious children. In contrast, authoritative parenting, which balances structure with warmth, fosters confident, socially adept, and emotionally stable children. He added that Permissive parenting, marked by indulgence and minimal discipline, can result in children who struggle with self-control and authority. Neglectful parenting, defined by a lack of involvement, can severely hinder a child's emotional and cognitive development.

Dr. Purushotham emphasized that authoritative parenting is most beneficial for nurturing well-rounded, resilient children. He also highlighted the need for parents to adapt their styles based on their child's temperament and developmental needs. The session concluded with a call for greater awareness among parents to ensure their approaches foster healthy growth, self-esteem, and independence in their children.

Session 5: The session titled "Child and Adolescent Substance Addictions: What We Need to Do?" began at 3:25 PM and featured Dr. Shilpashree, Senior Consultant and In-Charge of the Center for De-addiction at SNR Hospital in Kolar.

Chairperson: Dr.Jagdamba, Prof & HoD Physiology, SDUMC, SDUAHER Kolar

Dr. Shilpashri's session focused on the rising concern of substance addiction among children and adolescents, highlighting the key challenges and necessary interventions. She emphasized that early exposure to substances such as alcohol, tobacco, and drugs can severely impact brain development, leading to long-term physical and psychological issues.

The session witnessed the importance of early detection and intervention through collaborative efforts between parents, educators, and healthcare professionals. Dr. Shilpashri stressed the need for increased awareness and education on the signs of addiction, encouraging open communication between adults and young individuals.

She discussed on the Preventive strategies which included promoting healthy coping mechanisms, fostering resilience, and creating support systems within schools and communities. Dr. Shilpashri also advocated for stronger regulatory measures and access to rehabilitation services tailored to young people.

In conclusion, she emphasized a proactive, multi-faceted approach to combat substance addiction, stating that early action can mitigate the long-term consequences on children and adolescents.

Session 6: The session titled "Empowering Adolescents: Creative Approaches to Promote Mental Health" began at 4:00 PM and featured Dr. Latha K, Associate Professor in the Department of Mental Health Education at NIMHANS.

Dr. Latha K conducted an insightful session on "Empowering Adolescents: Creative Approaches to Promote Mental Health," emphasizing the need to address the unique mental health challenges faced by adolescents today. She highlighted how adolescence is a critical period of emotional and psychological development, making mental health interventions crucial.

Dr. Latha introduced several creative approaches, including art therapy, music, journaling, and mindfulness exercises, as effective tools to help adolescents express their emotions and cope with

stress. These techniques, she explained, offer non-verbal outlets that foster self-expression, emotional regulation, and resilience. She also discussed the role of supportive environments, encouraging schools and families to adopt mental health-promoting practices.

A key takeaway was the importance of early intervention and destigmatizing mental health conversations, helping adolescents develop healthy coping mechanisms before issues escalate. The session concluded with practical tips for parents, educators, and counselors to create safe, open spaces for adolescents to explore their mental well-being. Dr. Latha's session reinforced the idea that creativity, combined with mental health awareness, can empower adolescents to navigate their challenges more effectively.

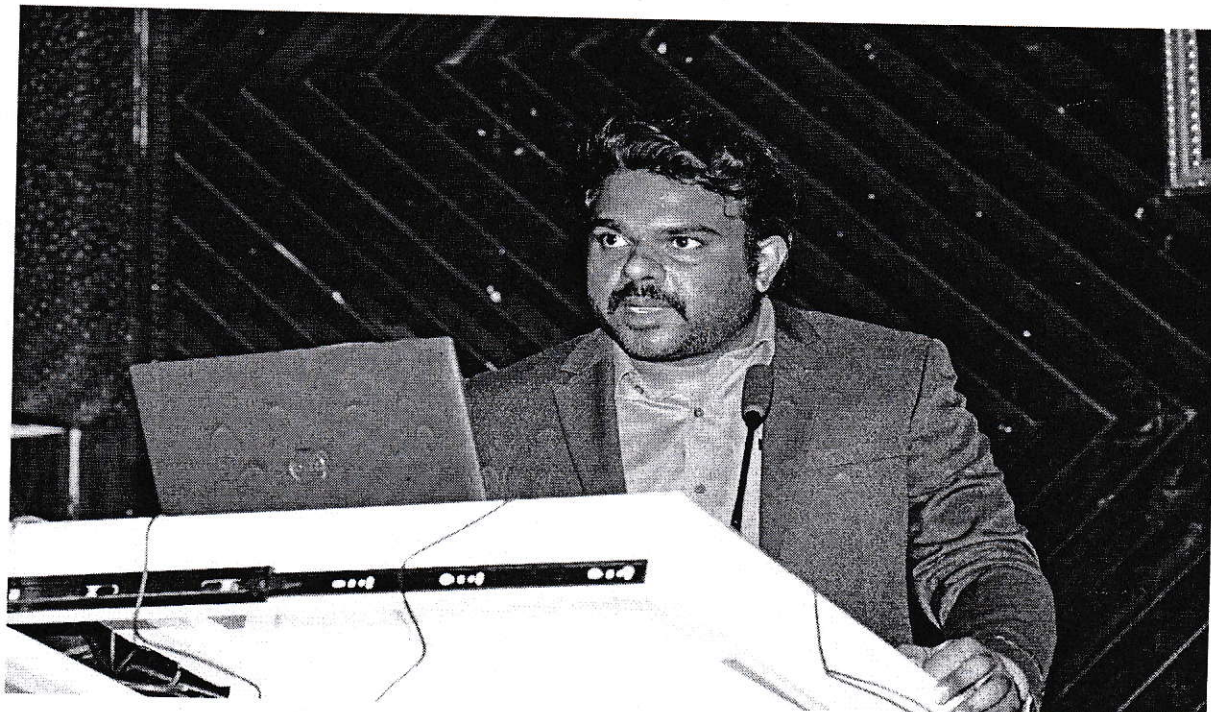


Fig 8- Dr Vivek Jayan delivering Vote of Thanks

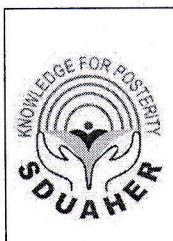
REGISTRATION:

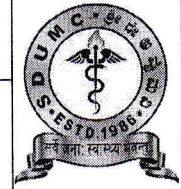
INAUGURATION:

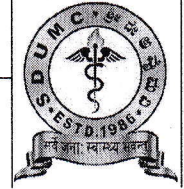
