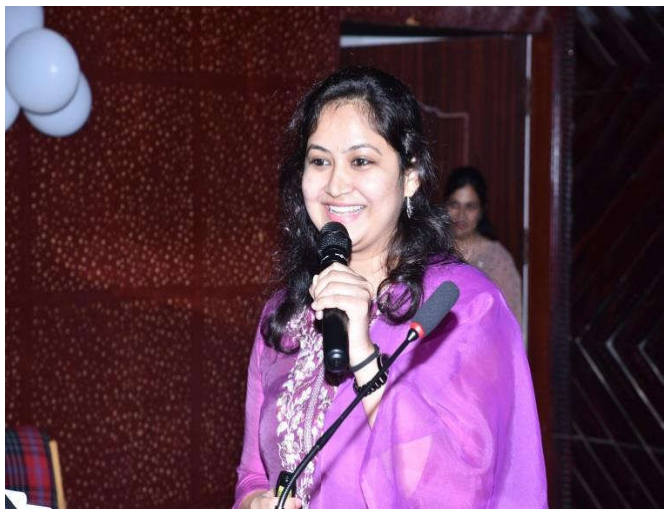
### Highlights of the events:
