CATARACT AWARENESS MONTH

Cataract is one of the leading causes of vision loss, especially in people aged 60 and above. It causes the lens of the eye to become cloudy, leading to blurred or dim vision. Risk factors include aging, diabetes, smoking, eye injury, and prolonged sun exposure. In younger individuals, cataracts can result from genetic disorders or trauma. Fortunately, cataracts are treatable through safe and effective surgery. Early detection and timely treatment can restore clear vision and improve quality of life.



What is Cataract?

It is the clouding of the eye's natural lens, leading to blurred vision, glare, and reduced contrast sensitivity. It is most commonly age-related but may also result from trauma, diabetes, or medication use. Cataract is a leading cause of reversible vision loss and is effectively treated with surgery, involving lens removal and intraocular lens implantation.
