“As a part of Faculty Development Programme for the faculty of the Academy. In view of this, **Dr. Pretesh R Kiran**, Associate Professor, Department of Community Medicine, Faculty Department of Medical Education, St. John’s Medical College, Bengaluru was invited as a resource person for the workshop & Dr. Sarala. N, Professor & HoD of Pharmacology was the Organizing Secretary.

The workshop focused on familiarizing participants with the OSPE and OSCE assessments and their role in evaluating clinical and practical competencies.. Sessions provided an overview of the structure, purpose, and implementation of these station-based examinations. Faculty members were trained in the design and development of OSPE & OSCE stations, with emphasis on constructing clear tasks, structured checklists and balanced distribution of activities across cognitive, effective, and psychomotor domains. Participants also visited nine demonstration stations prepared by different departments, where examples of well-designed stations were displayed. This activity helped participants observe how various skill domains and content areas can be effectively integrated into structured assessment stations.
