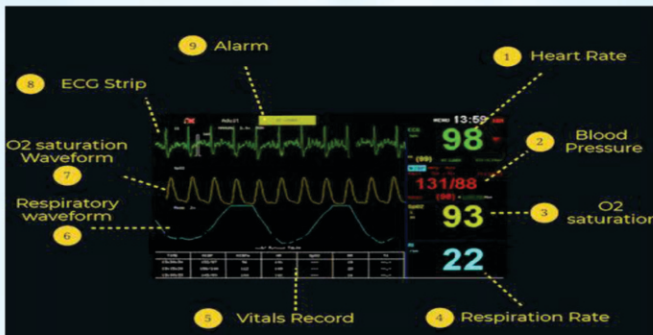

Overview of our Program

While monitors enhance patient safety they are only as reliable as their proper functioning and clinician interpreting them.
