

ADMISSION TO MBBS (2026-27)

Sri Devaraj Urs Medical College, situated in Kolar, Karnataka, is affiliated with Sri Devaraj Urs Academy of Higher Education and Research, recognized as a deemed-to-be University. Since its inception in 1986, the college has been offering undergraduate program (MBBS) and currently has an intake of 250 students.



The institution also provides postgraduate programs (MD/MS) in various broad specialties and super specialties like M.Ch program in Surgical Oncology and the M.Ch program in Urology.

The College has 21 departments which offer postgraduate degree courses. Currently there are **177 postgraduate seats** in various disciplines. Thirteen departments run Ph.D. programs with 3 interdisciplinary Ph.D. programs.

The Medical Education Unit of our college is vibrant with dedicated, enthusiastic faculty trained with FAIMER fellowship, ACME and revised basic MET training.



R L Jalappa Hospital and Research Centre, the teaching hospital of the medical college was established in 1994 with the objective of providing accessible, high-quality healthcare services to the residents of Kolar and neighbouring districts of Karnataka, Tamil Nadu and Andhra Pradesh. The primary goal of the hospital is to ensure that patients receive excellent medical care in their local community, emphasizing affordability and proximity to their homes.

Today R L Jalappa Hospital and Research Centre is a 1360 bedded well equipped tertiary care multispecialty hospital attached to Sri Devaraj Urs Medical College, a constituent unit of Sri Devaraj Urs Academy of Higher Education and Research catering to the population of economically backward area. It aims to provide high end tertiary health care complying with global standards at an affordable cost and at the same time join hands to conduct high quality healthcare research thereby contributing to medical science.

This is the only centre providing super specialty services in various health care in this region and stands out in emergency medical and surgical care particularly for life threatening, complicated high-risk cases and pandemic outbreaks

R L Jalappa Hospital and Research Center takes its pride in having qualified, competent and experienced Doctors, Nurses and other skilled staff, all working collaboratively to provide exceptional healthcare services. The hospital provides affordable, inclusive, and integrated approach to quality healthcare by including the services from Department of Cell biology and Molecular Genetics, Department of Speech Pathology and Audiology, Department of Physiotherapy, Department of Integrated Medicine and Department of Nutrition & Dietetics which comes under Allied Health Sciences of this University contributing to treatment of patient and research. The hospital has a MoU with Narayana Hrudayalaya, Bengaluru for managing cardiac cases.

The state - of - art Critical Care Units and Operation theatres of the hospital have rendered top quality service to critically ill patients and has been the only center in this region attending to emergency and other illnesses efficiently thereby, saving many precious lives.

The Nephrology and Dialysis services block has 22 dialysis units and is treating patients with end stage renal diseases thereby saving many lives.

R L Jalappa Hospital and Research Center stands out as the exclusive healthcare facility in the region to have earned accreditation from NABL (National Accreditation Board for Testing and Calibration Laboratories) and NABH (National Accreditation Board for Hospitals and Healthcare Providers). The Medical College also runs its own Primary Health care facility runs an Urban Health Training Centre in Kolar town and a Rural Health Training Centre. Family adoption program is being conducted successfully and all elements of competency based medical education are delivered in a well-structured curriculum.

Various health awareness events of importance are conducted regularly, by involving students as outreach activity. This community oriented approach helps the students obtain first-hand information on the health issues of the community and create awareness among them. The students are regularly posted to health camps where they interact with the patients and their relatives in a compassionate manner under the guidance of the faculty. During these sessions they develop team building skills and learn to work in a health care team.

I Admission Procedure

Eligibility for admission to M.B.B.S. degree course:

a) NEET-UG 2026 Performance:

- Candidates must have appeared for the NEET-UG 2026 and must have a rank in the merit list of NEET-UG 2026 for admission to MBBS Course.

b) Academic Qualifications:

Candidates should have passed 10+2 Education or its equivalent with PCB and English and should have obtained the minimum percentage of marks in the qualifying examination as per the norms of the National Medical Commission, New Delhi.

- Candidates must have passed Physics, Chemistry, Biology and English individually.
- A minimum 50% of marks is required in aggregate of Physics, Chemistry, and Biology.
- For SC/ST/OBC candidates, the aggregate requirement is 40%.
- Candidates with benchmark disabilities need a minimum aggregate of 45%, in compliance with the Rights of Persons with Disabilities Act, 2016.
- Must have a rank in the Merit list of NEET-UG 2026 for admission to MBBS course.

c) Selection Process:

- Admission will be granted based on NEET-UG 2026 scores within the respective categories.

d) Additional Information:

- There shall be no reservation for OBC/SC/ST/PWD/EWS candidates in deemed to be universities as per MCC.
- For all other eligibility conditions, the website of the National Medical Commission, New Delhi may be referred.

Counseling Process by MCC:

- **National Counseling:** All 100% of seats of deemed universities will be filled through National-level online counselling by the Medical Counselling Committee (MCC) of DGHS, New Delhi.
- **Counseling Rounds:** There are four rounds - Round 1, Round 2, Round 3, and Stray Vacancy Round. All rounds will be conducted through online by the MCC as per schedule of counseling.
- **Registration:** To become eligible for allotment of a seat, candidates are required to register on the MCC website: www.mcc.nic.in. Keep checking the site for updates and counseling schedules.

Freeze Candidates:

- **Reporting:** Freeze candidates must report to the Institute along with the allotment order and Original documents for physical verification and admission. Pay the entire tuition fee and admission charges fee for the year 2026-27.
- **Documents:** Candidates must bring all original certificates along with 3 sets of self-attested photo copies to the institute for physical verification.

The amount of fee to be deducted in case candidate resigns after counseling period / cutoff date:

Where any student discontinues from the MBBS course after admission for any reason, either on or after the cut-off date prescribed by the statutory and/or University authorities for admission to the first year of the course, or where the seat is rendered vacant without having any chance of being filled up with any other candidate, such students will have to remit the tuition fee and other applicable fees for the 'entire/ remaining duration of course period'.

V General Information:

- If you provide false information or fake documents, your admission will be cancelled, fees will not be returned, and you could face legal action.
- You must report in person on the date and time given by the MCC in your allotment order. Bring all original documents and make sure your tuition fee payment is complete.
- If your original documents are with another institution, you need to retrieve them. Admission will not be completed if you only bring a certificate stating your documents are elsewhere.
- Once admitted, you must follow the university's rules regarding the syllabus, exams, fees, and conduct.
- The university can change any rules to comply with official regulations from time to time.
- You must pay all tuition and other fees by the due dates in the coming years. If you don't, your name will be removed from the college rolls.
- You must be present yourself for counseling and admission. No one else can represent you.
- Any disputes about these rules will be decided by the Vice Chancellor, and their decision is final.
- Try not to take long leave and aim to finish your course on time. No student shall be allowed to continue MBBS course after nine (09) years from the date of admission into the course.
- Your name and date of birth will be registered as in your certificate of qualifying exam passed. No changes will be allowed later, so check these details carefully during admission.

Anti-Ragging Policy:

- Ragging is strictly banned and is a punishable crime. The university follows strict rules to prevent ragging, in line with national regulations.

Compulsory Rotating Medical Internship (CRMI):

- **Mandatory Internship:** After you pass the final MBBS Part II exam, candidates must do a 12-month medical internship. This is a key part of your training.
- **Completion Time:** Candidates should complete the twelve months period of internship within two years of passing final MBBS part II examination.
- **No CRMI Transfer:** The candidates shall complete their entire period of CRMI training at R.L.Jalappa Hospital & Research Centre, teaching hospital attached to Sri Devaraj Urs Medical College, where they have pursued and completed their MBBS degree course.
