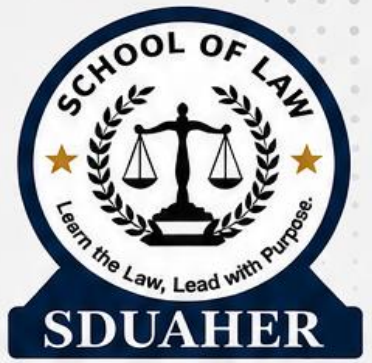
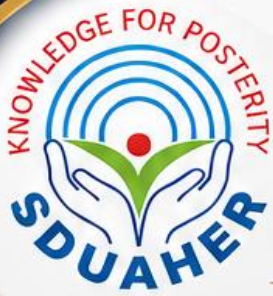

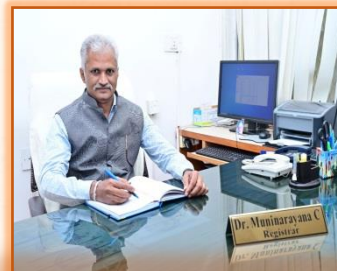

ADMISSION PROCESS

Applications for the 3-Year LL.B. Programme can be successfully submitted by:

- Filling the application form with relevant details and uploading the following documents:
 - Formal Passport Size Photograph (White Background)
 - SSLC / 10th Standard Marks Card
 - 11th Standard Marks Card
 - 2nd PUC / 12th Standard Marks Card
 - Caste Certificate (if applicable)
- Payment of the prescribed Application Fee of Rs. 1,000/-

On Submission and Payment of Application Fee

- Applicants will receive an automated confirmation email upon successful submission.
- Shortlisted candidates will be informed regarding the Offline Entrance Examination. Examination dates will be communicated one week in advance for outstation candidates.
- The Entrance Examination will be followed by a Two-Step Interview Process.

Entrance Examination Pattern

- Total Marks: 50 Marks
- Duration: 1 Hour
- Pattern: MCQs and Descriptive Questions

Major Components of the Examination:

- Legal Aptitude
- Analogy
- Current Affairs
- English Language
- Passage-Based Questions

Shortlisted candidates will be intimated regarding their selection through email or Phonecall.

ELIGIBILITY CERTIFICATE

Applicants who have passed the qualifying examination from Universities other than those located in Karnataka State / Karnataka PU Board / CBSE must obtain an Eligibility Certificate issued by the Registrar of Sri Devaraj Urs Academy of Higher Education and Research.

The certificate can be obtained by submitting the prescribed application form along with:

- Attested photocopies of Marks Statements
- Migration Certificate
- Prescribed Fees as notified by the Registrar

No admission shall be granted without submission of the Eligibility Certificate.

MIGRATION CERTIFICATE

Students who have studied under Boards or Universities other than the Karnataka Pre-University Board and students who have completed Degree Courses from other Universities must submit a Migration Certificate at the time of admission.

➤ Add-On Programmes

The School of Law offers various add-on and skill development programmes aimed at enhancing practical legal knowledge and professional competencies. These programmes help students gain exposure to advocacy skills, drafting, legal research, communication skills, mediation, arbitration, cyber law, intellectual property rights, and emerging areas of law, thereby preparing them for the evolving legal profession.

➤ Placements and Internships

The institution actively supports students in securing internships and placements through collaborations with law firms, advocates, corporate organizations, NGOs, legal aid centres, and judicial institutions. Internship opportunities provide students with practical exposure to court procedures, legal drafting, client counselling, litigation practices, and corporate legal work, thereby enhancing career readiness and professional confidence.

➤ Library

The library resources are constantly updated with current publications. It has a large collection of textbooks, reference books, and multimedia resources, which are continuously updated with the latest editions. The College subscribes to national and international periodicals, databases, and online journals. Students can access online databases, journals, and library catalogues. The digital section of the library provides full-text documents and faculty publications. The library also offers spacious reading areas both inside and outside the library premises.

➤ Moot Court

In order to become a successful legal professional, it is essential for students to understand the practical application of law and court etiquette. The Moot Court Committee of the School of Law actively organizes various mooting activities throughout the academic year, including intra-college and national-level moot court competitions. Students have represented the institution in national and international moot court competitions, trial advocacy competitions, and client counselling events, gaining valuable advocacy and courtroom experience.

➤ Research and Innovation

The University has a dedicated Research and Development (R&D) Department that encourages students and faculty members to engage in academic research, article writing, seminars, conferences, workshops, and journal publications. The institution also has an active Institutions Innovation Council (IIC), which promotes innovation, creativity, entrepreneurship, and multidisciplinary talents among students by providing guidance, mentorship, and institutional support, including funding opportunities for innovative projects and activities.

➤ Counselling and Student Support

Personal and non-academic counselling services are provided by trained counsellors to support and motivate students.
