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Agenda 1: SдуаHER/IQAC- I/01/2025-26

Subject: Approval of the Proceedings of the Previous IQAC Meeting.

Discussion: The committee has reviewed, validated, and formally approved the minutes of the previous IQAC meeting held on 18-03-2026, ensuring that all discussions and decisions have been recorded.

Agenda No. 2: SдуаHER/IQAC-IV/02/2025–26

Action Taken Report on the decisions of the previous IQAC meeting held on 18-03-2026

Discussion: The Action Taken Report on the resolutions passed in the previous IQAC meeting held on 18-03-2026 was presented before the committee. The IQAC reviewed the implementation status of all decisions and expressed satisfaction with the progress made. The report was discussed in detail and subsequently approved by the members.

Further updates on specific agenda items were presented as follows:

Regarding Agenda – 3: Implementation Process for Integrating Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs 3, 4, 5, 6, 13, and 17). Dr. Prabhakar emphasized that each SDG Committee should undertake SDG-focused research and related activities, with the respective SDG Convenors responsible for monitoring their implementation. Dr. Senthil informed the members that the Key Performance Indicators (KPIs) for SDG activities are under development and will be circulated to the SDG Chairpersons and Convenors to facilitate effective planning, monitoring, and documentation of activities.

Regarding agenda – 4: Recruitment of PhD-Qualified Faculty, Revision of Ph.D. Programme Duration, and Introduction of D.Sc. Programme: Dr. Senthil informed the members that the proposal to revise the Ph.D. programme duration to three years will be placed before the Executive Council for approval by September 2026. He further stated that the regulations for the D.Sc. programme are under preparation and will be presented to the Board of Studies (BoS) for approval. The programme details and related documentation will be prepared by Dr. Prabhakar and Dr. Dayanand.

Regarding ERP-LMS integration: the process is currently under implementation, Feedback process is completed. Necessary modifications are being carried out to enable effective monitoring of faculty usage and academic activities.

Regarding 30% Growth in Scopus-Indexed Publications: New APC revision is done and approved, incentives for scopus and Web of Science is different and its updated in policy.

Publication Incentive Policy: Dr. Kalyani, Director R & D, informed the members that the revised Publication Incentive Policy has been approved and will be implemented with effect from **April 2026**. The committee noted that the revised policy aims to encourage high-quality research publications and enhance the institution's research output.



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Regarding Progress on ISO Certification: Department-wise implementation of processes is currently in progress. **And ERP:** The process of modifying the ERP software for online management is currently in progress. The system is expected to become fully operational upon completion of the ongoing technical enhancements.

Regarding discussion on NAAC According to BAF: Dr. Senthil, instructed all NAAC Criteria Convenors to coordinate with Mr. Natesh and the IQAC for uploading the Academic Year 2024–25 criterion-wise data and supporting documents on the University website by the first week of July. He further informed that the collection and compilation of criterion-wise documents for the Academic Year 2025–26 should commence immediately thereafter to ensure timely preparation for the NAAC accreditation process under the Binary Accreditation Framework (BAF).

Agenda – 3: SDUAHER/IQAC-I/03/2025–26

Subject: Review and Update on the NABH Accreditation Process

Discussion: The members were informed that the hospital has successfully renewed its National Accreditation Board for Hospitals & Healthcare Providers (NABH) accreditation 6th Edition. The accreditation has been continued for the next three years, reaffirming the hospital's commitment to maintaining high standards of patient care, quality, and safety.

Agenda – 4: SDUAHER/IQAC-I/04/2026–25

Subject: Review of NABL Progress and Compliance

Discussion: NABL Accreditation: The committee was informed that the hospital laboratory has successfully completed the NABL renewal assessment conducted on 13 April 2026 and has received the National Accreditation Board for Testing and Calibration Laboratories (NABL) accreditation certificate. The accreditation is valid for a period of four years, reaffirming the laboratory's compliance with national quality standards and its commitment to providing reliable and quality-assured diagnostic services.

Agenda – 5: SDUAHER/IQAC-I/05/2025–26

Subject: Update on NIRF Ranking

Discussion: Dr. Senthil emphasized the need to strengthen the institution's performance across key ranking parameters, including research publications, patents, consultancy, outreach and extension activities, graduate outcomes, perception, and academic excellence. The institution is currently awaiting the official declaration of NIRF 2025 rankings.



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Agenda – 6: SDUAHER/IQAC-I/06/2025–26

Subject: Conduct of Academic and Administrative Audit (AAA) Internal Audit -July August 2026

Discussion: Dr. Senthil informed the members that the Academic and Administrative Audit (AAA) Internal Audit for the Academic Year 2025–26 is scheduled to be conducted during July–August 2026. He briefed the committee on the proposed audit schedule, documentation requirements, constitution of audit teams, and the need for timely completion of departmental preparations. The tentative audit schedule was presented as follows: Faculty of Pharmacy & Law – **27 July 2026**; Faculty of Nursing – **28–29 July 2026**; Faculty of Allied & Health Care Professions – **30–31 July 2026**; and Faculty of Medicine – **1–7 August 2026**. All constituent units were instructed to ensure readiness of documents and extend full cooperation to the audit teams for the successful conduct of the AAA Internal Audit.

Agenda – 7: SDUAHER/IQAC-I/07/2025–26

Subject: Presentation of Baseline KPI Data for Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) – Academic Year 2024–25

Discussion: Presentation of Baseline KPI Data for Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) – Academic Year 2024–25: The baseline Key Performance Indicator (KPI) data for SDGs 3, 4, 5, 6, 13, and 17 were presented and reviewed. Dr. Senthil highlighted the current status of the KPIs, identifying areas where targets had been achieved and areas requiring improvement or pending data collection. The members were advised to strengthen documentation, implement targeted interventions to achieve the identified KPIs, and ensure regular monitoring through the respective SDG Committees for effective integration of the Sustainable Development Goals across the institution.

Agenda – 8: SDUAHER/IQAC-I/08/2025–26

Subject: Presentation of Academic and Administrative Audit (AAA) Report and Institutional Targets

Discussion: The Academic and Administrative Audit (AAA) Report was presented, highlighting the key recommendations and institutional performance across all criteria. Dr. Senthil emphasized the need to implement the peer team's recommendations by strengthening outcome-based education, research and publications, faculty development, industry and academic collaborations, student support initiatives, infrastructure, governance, and institutional best practices. The members were instructed to prepare department-wise action plans with measurable targets and ensure periodic monitoring through the IQAC to address the identified gaps and enhance institutional quality.



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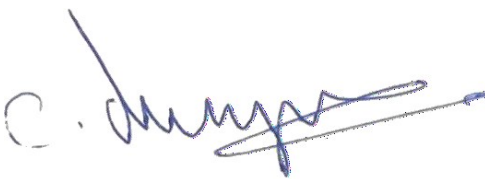
Agenda – 9: SDUAHER/IQAC-I/09/2025–26

Subject: Any Other Matter

Executive Development Programme (EDP): The Hon'ble Vice Chancellor instructed the Faculty of Medicine to submit the details of the Fellowship Programmes currently being offered and to identify potential programmes for implementation under the Executive Development Programme (EDP). Madam, further recommended appointing a Programme Coordinator to oversee the planning, coordination, and implementation of EDP initiatives in consultation with Dr. Prabhakar, Dean, Faculty of Medicine, and Dr. Dayanand, Dean, Faculty of Allied Health Sciences. Both Deans agreed to coordinate the process and submit the proposal for initiating EDP programmes. Dr. T.N. Suresh informed the committee that one Fellowship Programme has already commenced in the Department of Pathology, with two candidates admitted under the Executive Development Programme.
